On behalf of the the Oak Park River Forest Infant Welfare Society board of directors, I am writing to request a waiver of the fidelity bond requirement for obtaining a raffle license. As noted in the attached application, the OPRF Infant Welfare Society is a 104-year-old, not-for-profit organization that provides medical, dental and behavioral health services to children in need in Forest Park, Oak Park and surrounding communities. For the past 22 years we have conducted a volunteer-run Holiday Housewalk fundraiser in December to help fund the IWS Children's Clinic. The COVID pandemic has made this --our largest annual fundraiser -- unworkable this year. Instead we are producing a new event that combines a Virtual Holiday Housewalk with a Raffle, whose drawing of the winning ticket will occur on December 30 in Forest Park.

The OPRF Infant Welfare Society is a financially solvent organization with unrestricted financial assets in excess of \$1.6 million. We seek the bond waiver to save the cost of purchasing insurance, so that all of the proceeds of this event can be directed to services for the children who benefit from the IWS Children's Clinic. We hope that our solid financial position and our well-known reputation will be important factors as you consider our request for the bond waiver.

We respectfully seek your consideration in waiving the fidelity bond, and appreciate your assistance in moving this request and our application through the Village's process. Thank you for your consideration of this request.

The undersigned hereby attest that all statements made herein are true and correct to the best of our knowledge. The undersigned further certify that they have read Chapter 3-16 of the Village of Forest Park Code, and that the organization which they represent is qualified and eligible to obtain a raffle license in the Village of Forest Park according to the requirements as set forth in 230 ILCS 15-0.01 et seq. (State of Illinois Raffles Act) and the Village of Forest Park Municipal Code Section 3-16, and further certify that we will abide by all rules and regulations as set forth by the State of Illinois and the Village of Forest Park. Oak Park River Forest Infant Welfare Society 2020 Virtual Holiday Housewalk Grand Raffle Rules

The 2020 OPRF Infant Welfare Society (IWS) Grand Raffle is a new feature of the organization's largest annual fundraising event, the Virtual Holiday Housewalk (VHHW). Raffle tickets are purchased as part of the VHHW video experience. Pricing is as follows:

- \$55 = VHHW all access + 1 grand raffle ticket
- \$100 = VHHW all access + 2 grand raffle tickets (save \$10)
- \$225 = VHHW all access + 5 grand raffle tickets (save \$50)
- \$500 = VHHW all access + 12 grand raffle tickets (save \$160)
- \$725 = VHHW all access + 18 grand raffle tickets (save \$265)
- \$1000 = VHHW all access + 25 grand raffle tickets (save \$375)

Tickets for the VHHW and raffle are sold online through the VHHW ticket sales and video event website using the OneCause event management platform as well as offline to IWS Circle members and others paying by check through the IWS office or through Circle treasurers. IWS will print out contact information for each raffle ticket buyer, multiplied by the number of tickets purchased by each buyer. IWS will cut the strip of tickets into single tickets and place them into a mixer wheel bin from which the winning ticket will be drawn.

The maximum number of tickets sold will be 5,000.

There will be a single winning ticket with a prize of \$10,000. The winner will not be physically present since the drawing will be held virtually online.

The drawing will take place on Wednesday, December 30, 2020 in Forest Park, Illinois, at 3 p.m. at a location to be confirmed. The drawing will be conducted by an impartial individual designated by IWS (an IWS director, officer, employee, or member) no ties to the raffle or any decision made affecting the raffle. The IWS Raffle Manager is not eligible to win.

The winner must be at least 18 years of age and must reside in Illinois.

OPRF Infant Welfare Society will contact the winner on December 30, 2020 by telephone, text and/or email, and will mail a confirming letter no later than January 4, 2021. IWS' communications will provide the winner with instructions on how to claim their prize at the earliest convenience to both parties.

The winner will need to provide a government-issued photo ID to claim the raffle prize, which will be awarded by a check from the OPRF Infant Welfare Society.

IWS will take a photograph of the winner during the check presentation to be shared via appropriate IWS communication (newsletter, social media, annual report, etc.) If requested, IWS will publish only the winner's first name for privacy purposes.

The winner is responsible for reporting their winnings to the Internal Revenue Service and to their state Department of Revenue for income tax calculations.

The undersigned corporation, for the purpose of amending its Articles of Incorporation and pursuant to the provisions of Section 35 of the "General Not For Profit Corporation Act" of the State of Illinois, hereby executes the following Articles of Amendment:

1. The name of the corporation is: THE OAK PARK AND RIVER FOREST INFANT WELFARE SOCIETY

3. (a) At a meeting of members, at which a quorum was present, held on June 22 same receiving at least two-thirds (2/3) of the votes entitled to be cast by the members of the corporation present or represented by proxy at such meeting,

the following amendment or amendments were adopted in the manner prescribed by the "General Not For Profit Corporation Act" of the State of Illinois:
RESOLVED, that the Articles of Incorporation of this corporation be amended in the following respects:

(1) By striking out all of that article designated 2, and, concurrently, inserting in lieu thereof and in substitution therefor a new article 2 to be and read as follows:

2. The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are: (a) to maintain and support, or contribute funds and services toward the maintenance and support of, such Infant Welfare Stations in Oak Park and River Forest and at such other places in Cook County, Illinois, as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine; (b) to assist in the work of the Infant Welfare Society of Chicago; (c) to contribute funds and services toward the maintenance and support of one or more stations of the Infant Welfare Society of Chicago, in such amounts and to such extent as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine; and (d) to promote the general health and welfare of infants, children and women, in such manner as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine.

(2) By striking out all of that article designated 3, and, concurrently, inserting in lieu thereof and in substitution therefor a new article 3 to be and read as follows:

3. The number of directors shall be not less than three and hereafter the number of directors shall be fixed as provided by the by-laws.
