


## Calls


The Fire Department responded to 287 calls in the month of September. That is an average of 9.5 calls per day for the month. 65% of the calls were for EMS. 35% were for fire/service calls.

## **Major Incidents**


The Forest Park Fire Department responded to 2 structure fires in the month of September.

**1133 Elgin Forest Park**- We responded to a fire in a 2 flat. Crew found extensive fire on the second floor and up in the attic. We received assistance from Oak Park, River Forest, Berwyn, Cicero, and North Riverside and Maywood mutual aid towns. A fire investigation Box Alarm was called to help find the cause of the fire.





**7540 Roosevelt Forest Park**- responded to a fire on the roof of the mall. Crew put out small fire. Assisted by North Riverside.



**Inspections-** For the month of September we conducted 20 commercial inspections. 6 violations noted. We conducted 10 residential inspections with 1 violation found.
